COMMUNITY ORGANIZATIONS BENEFIT FROM UNION PACIFIC MOVE

In May, Union Pacific employees in Omaha began the task of moving into a new 1.3 million square foot office building across the street from their former headquarters at 14th and Dodge. The new, 19-story building occupies an entire city block and consolidates UP employees from 10 locations across Omaha.

UP departments prepared to move by sorting through and packing up offices, file cabinets, and storage closets. As the process progressed, employees began to set aside large amounts of usable office supplies that would not be moved to the new office building. As early as April, the Exchange began receiving phone calls and emails from various departments advising us about hundreds of report covers, binders, paper, desk trays and miscellaneous supplies that UP employees did not want to discard, but had to be removed from the old office building.

The Exchange quickly began contacting nonprofit organizations, primarily in the Omaha area, to alert them to the availability of the materials. As more supplies began to accumulate, Union Pacific organized several "give-away" events so organizations could pick up materials on specific days.

In the past several months over 30 nonprofit agencies and schools have received 2,100 binders, 700 hanging file folders, and hundreds of markers, staplers, hole punches, and report covers. We would like to thank all those Union Pacific employees who worked to ensure these supplies stayed out of the landfill so they could be reused by local organizations.

NONPROFIT ASSOCIATION OF THE MIDLANDS

Several years ago the Exchange was working to expand the participation of nonprofit organizations and schools. Our goal was to assist these organizations in locating needed materials and to respond more quickly when businesses contacted the Exchange to list excess and unwanted items.

Through that effort, Exchange facilitators established a partnership with The Nonprofit Association of the Midlands (NAM). NAM provides assistance, support and guidance to member agencies in Nebraska and Southwest Iowa. Their mission is to "increase the member organizations' capacity to deliver programs and services efficiently and effectively in response to community needs."

NAM's nearly 150 member agencies include human services providers, arts and theater groups, and church outreach organizations. NAM has provided Materials Exchange facilitators the opportunity to reach these organizations quickly when needed material becomes available. As a result, agencies who might not have considered participation in the Exchange have received office supplies, furniture, and other useful material. In addition, businesses donating items have avoided storage and disposal costs as items are often picked up by these organizations within a few days.

A professional-size air hockey table was donated by a Lincoln business to an emergency shelter for at-risk youth.

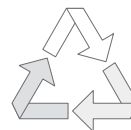


A seed company donated 3,000 plastic bags to an Omaha homeless shelter. The bags were used for the 1,200 sack lunches prepared each week by the shelter staff.

So far in 2004, 20,000# of plastic waste that had been going to Nebraska landfills, has been diverted to a concrete statuary manufacturer to be used as packaging material.

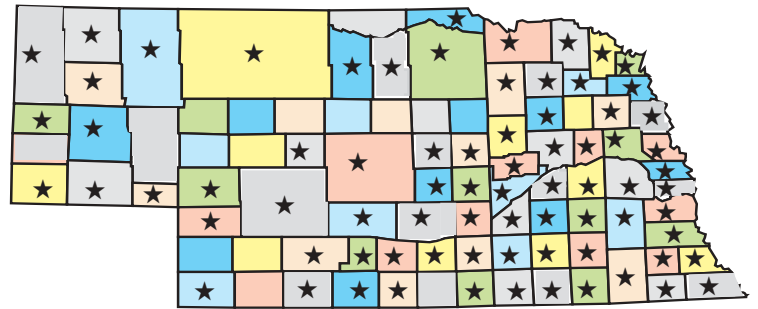

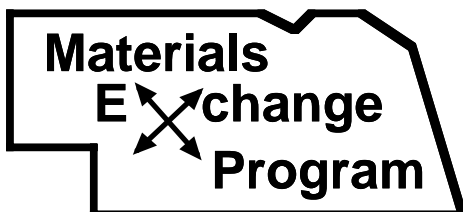
