Exchange Program Helps Outfit Beatrice Humane Society Office

The new Beatrice Humane Society office will open in January equipped with office supplies and furniture found by the Nebraska Materials Exchange Program.

A group of Beatrice citizens recently approached the city of Beatrice to organize a nonprofit organization designed to improve the treatment of stray animals picked up in Beatrice. The citizens wanted to provide support to the City of Beatrice in its animal control work. While the city had been operating a pound, the community members wanted to improve the city's facilities for dealing with stray animals.

The city council and the organizers of the Beatrice Humane Society entered into an agreement in which the city would renovate part of a former high school shop for use as a Humane Society facility. The city will provide a budget of \$10,000 to operate the facility which will maintain a more humane area for housing stray animals.

According to Materials Exchange Program representative Allen Grell, the group needed a variety of items to start up its operation.

"They needed office equipment including a fax machine, typewriter, computer, desk, chairs, waste paper baskets, a copier and shelves," Grell said. "We were able to locate all the items they requested."

The Materials Exchange Program provided more than 30 items to equip the office and saved the City of Beatrice and the Beatrice Humane Society some of their start up costs.

"Had the Beatrice Humane Society not been willing to reuse materials their start up costs would have been considerably higher," Grell said.

In addition, the managers of the Beatrice Walmart scheduled to open in January have already agreed to participate in the Materials Exchange Program by donating bags of dog food broken in shipping to the new facility.

"The store can't sell the broken bags of dog food but the managers don't want to waste the product," Grell said.

"They are planning ahead and helping the Humane Society to significantly reduce the costs of feeding animals housed there."

McCain Foods Gaylord Boxes Benefit 'Purty Punkins' Farmers

Purty Punkins of Big Springs, Nebraska saved \$17,500 by reusing 2,500 gaylord boxes from McCain Foods of Grand Island.

According to Anne and Brian Armstrong of Purty Punkins, the 40-inch by 48-inch by 36-inch boxes cost \$11 each when purchased new. The Nebraska Materials Exchange program put the Armstrongs in contact with McCain Foods who had the leftover boxes. The Armstrongs arranged to purchase the cardboard boxes for \$4 each from McCain Foods. Purty Punkins left a semi-truck trailer at McCain foods to collect the boxes.

The gaylord boxes were used to ship 85 semi-truck loads to South Dakota, Wyoming, Colorado, Idaho, Missouri, Utah, Iowa, Kansas and Nebraska. Each box held 1,300 pounds of pumpkins.

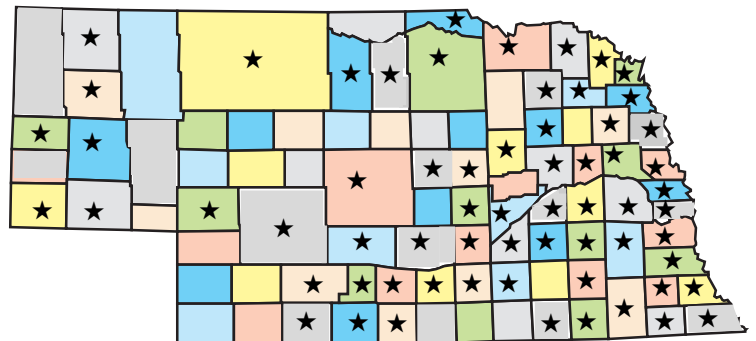

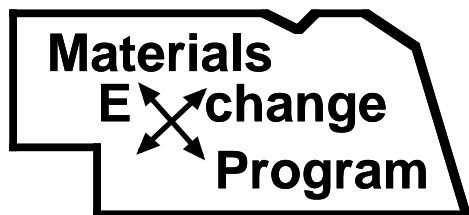

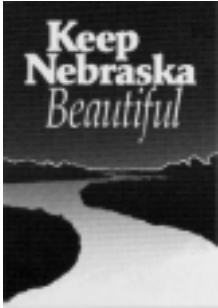
