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## MAD DADS Appreciate Donated Paint

When a Nebraska Materials Exchange program field representative asked MAD DADS Director Don Coleman what MAD DADS needed through the program, Coleman said, "We could use some paint."

Field representatives then put Coleman in touch with Athey Painting, Inc. of Lincoln, and a match was made. MAD DADS has received 40 gallons of paint from Athey Painting.

MAD DADS is an acronym for Men Against Destruction-Defending Against Drugs and Social-Disorder. The nonprofit organization was founded in 1989 by parents who wanted to stop gang violence and the distribution of illegal drugs in

the community. Volunteers painted the MAD DADS Learning Center, 427 S. 13th St., and covered graffiti on a viaduct in North Lincoln with the donated paint.

### **Program Participants Find Uses for Lincoln Benefit's Old Office Furniture**

Lincoln Benefit Life in Lincoln matched two tons of various office furniture and equipment with Nebraska Materials Exchange Program participants after the insurance company moved from its downtown Lincoln location to new offices in east Lincoln.

Larry McClellan of the *Johnson County Times* estimates that the newspaper collected about 9,160 pounds of items from Lincoln Benefit including seven desks, four computer desks, six chair mats, 75 cubicle panels of various sizes, and two word processors.

"We earnestly appreciate the opportunity to participate in this program," McClellan said. "With the potential to hopefully be expanding our company in the future, these items will certainly be beneficial in saving our capital."

Lakeview High School staff in Columbus were pleased with the 18 reception chairs, 13 wooden executive desks, four credenzas, three computer stands, five file cabinets, 12 monitors and 15 metal shelving units they collected.

The Gage County Chapter of American Red Cross got a secretarial desk, and Main Street Beatrice picked up two secretarial desks.

"The spirit of cooperation that made the entire project work was outstanding," said Jeanne Blinn of Main Street Beatrice.

Keep Nebraska Beautiful staff in Lincoln were also pleased to collect four cubicle panels and a computer table.

### **Materials Placed for Doane College**

Doane College in Crete matched more than two tons of various office furniture with Materials Exchange Program participants during March.

The representatives of the Board of Public Works in Beatrice were pleased with the conference table and 14 executive chairs they picked up. J-2 Well Services was able to use nine file cabinets, four shelving units, a wooden desk, four lab stools and 72-drawer cabinet. GravityOne took a VAX mainframe system.

### **Marking Flags Benefit Many**

American Marking Corporation representatives had 17,000 extra marking flags they wanted to keep out of the landfill. The preprinted polyethylene flags with a 21-inch wire shaft will now be used by Natural Resource Districts and counties for various projects.

"We have avoided the flags entrance into the Douglas County landfill and have saved the taxpayer's some money by arranging distribution to NRDs and counties," Field Representative Allen Grell reports.

### **Lincoln Teachers Find Uses for Pioneer Publishing Envelopes**

Teachers from throughout the Lincoln school district are excited about envelopes they have received free through the Nebraska Materials Exchange Program. Lincoln Public Schools took 57 boxes or 14,000 over-stocked envelopes from Pioneer Publishing in Friend to use for a variety of classroom projects.

Campbell Elementary School students are using the envelopes in their Coyote Express school mail system. Mary Abebe, a teacher at Campbell, was pleased to take some of the free envelopes for her students to use to address letters to their schoolmates.

Pyrtle Elementary School teachers are using the envelopes for a variety of reasons including letter-writing activities for students and communication with parents.

First grade teacher Sandy Lehman said her students were excited to use the envelopes for some of the letters they had written.



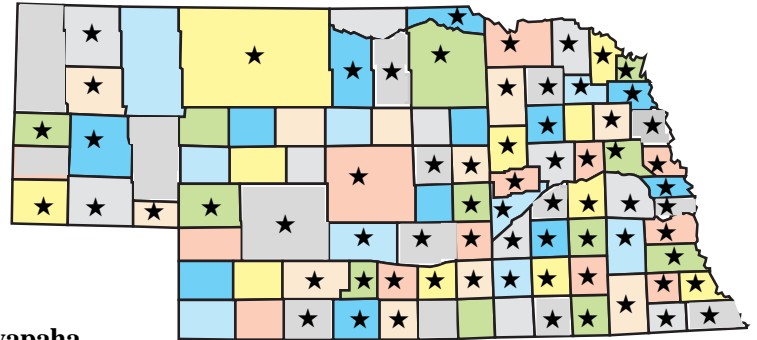

Since November 1999 WAY Ministries of Omaha has kept eight tons of computers and printers from the landfills through exchanges arranged by the Nebraska Materials Exchange Program.

WAY Ministries uses the equipment received to supply community centers with computers for education purposes.

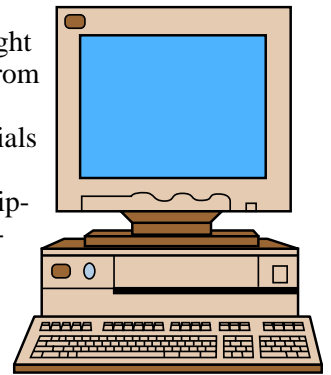
According to Jay Rohman of WAY Ministries, the main goal of the organization is racial

reconciliation among youth. The goal is achieved by setting up community centers and working with youth. Workshops for youth and parents also help achieve the WAY Ministries goal.

After-school programs at these centers provide computer and Internet access for youth. Volunteer staff help students with homework and basic computer skills.

Some of the computers will be sent to similar programs in Little Rock, Arkansas. WAY Ministries currently is working on suppling computers to missions in Haiti and Russia. Volunteers take the various pieces of computer equipment received from other organizations and businesses and set up complete units in working order that are network capable.

While computers matched with WAY Ministries have all been 386s or older, the computers have given computer access to youth who otherwise would not have had that opportunity.

There are less than 350 people in the Village of Plymouth, Nebraska, and when they wanted to set up their own library they needed to do it on a budget. Thanks to matches arranged by the Nebraska Materials Exchange Program the village has opened its new library.

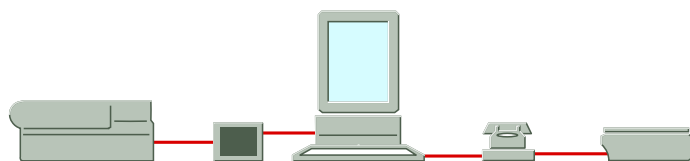

## Avoid Computer Disposal Problems

Is your electronic equipment becoming obsolete? What will you do with your old computer when you get a new one?

Due to increasing numbers of electronic equipment sent to landfills, Massachusetts environmental officials have instituted the nation's first ban on disposal of computer screens, television sets and other glass picture tubes in landfills and incinerators.

Cathode ray tubes (CRTs) in screens contain 5 to 8 pounds of lead that can seep into the groundwater under landfills or, if the tube is incinerated, get into the air.

Donating old, but **working** computer equipment to nonprofit organizations or individuals through the Nebraska Materials Exchange Program can help you avoid computer equipment disposal problems.

According to Field Representative Elaine Gilmore, a large network of participants are seeking current or outdated **working** equipment for reuse.

As more businesses and individuals update their equipment, the Materials Exchange Program looks forward to making many more matches with nonprofit, day care and school participants.

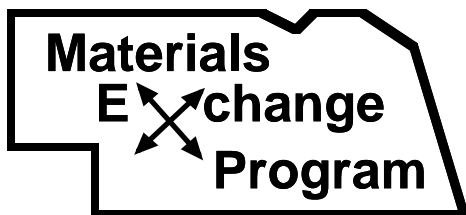

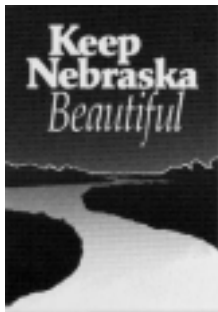
