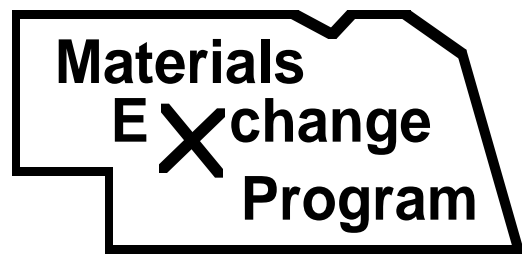

Is Y2K Bugging You? Materials Exchange offers a solution

With the constant release of newer, faster, and more powerful computers, coupled with the impending Y2K computer bug issue, companies worldwide are planning on purchasing or leasing new computer systems. While this may be a technological fix for present computer systems, it may create headaches for landfill and warehouse operators.

A 1997 survey conducted by Carnegie Mellon University estimated that consumers could landfill over 55 million personal computers and will recycle 150 million more by the year 2005. A previous survey estimated more than 148 million computers would be landfilled. Neither survey estimated the number of computers that businesses will indefinitely stockpile.

Fortunately for Nebraskans, the Materials Exchange Program offers several options beyond landfilling and stockpiling. Some participating schools located throughout the state are looking to reuse computers regardless of Y2K compatibility. There are also several participating nonprofit organizations looking for computers, printers and other peripherals.

The Materials Exchange also has several participants who will salvage non-working units containing functional components such as printed circuit boards and disk drives, or recyclable materials such as plastic, steel, aluminum, copper, lead, gold, barium, antimony, and others.

If you or your company is planning to upgrade your computers, one of your best waste management options for these outdated but still useful items is to find re-users or recyclers for the equipment. Please contact the Nebraska Materials Exchange Program for information on computer re-users or recyclers in your area.

New School Gets Used Desks, Saves Real Money

On March 16, Lutheran High Northeast moved to their new Norfolk campus which was recently furnished with desks found with the help of the Nebraska Materials Exchange Program.

"Had we not had the desks we would have used folding chairs in classrooms. This is a fantastic program—one that all schools should be aware of and take advantage of," states principal Paul Leckband.

The University of Nebraska-Lincoln originally approached the Materials Exchange Program with several classroom desks left over from a remodeling project. An exchange representative heard the Norfolk school was constructing a new building and contacted Mr. Leckband. Fortunately, they were just beginning to look for classroom furniture and had an interest in the university's desks.

About 200 desks were shipped to the new Norfolk school with the help of a third Exchange participant. "It's not just the materials, but it's the level of cooperation that's involved. It's really neat," says Leckband.

Based on estimates by the school and the Exchange Program, the match diverted more than 4.5 tons of materials from the landfill. Leckband told the exchange that "had the school opted for new, top-of-the-line student desks, it would have cost about \$13,000."

Presently the school, which plans to grow from this year's 62 students to more than 120 in the next 2-5 years, is also seeking other materials for their art and science labs as well as other multi-use items. Exchange Participant in the Spotlight: Wildlife Rescue

Wildlife Rescue, an all-volunteer service dedicated to the rescuing of hurt and injured wild animals, has been a member of the Nebraska Materials Exchange since 1995. Begun in 1979, the program now has over 285 volunteers located in Lincoln and Omaha.

The organization offers a hotline for people in Lincoln and Omaha who may find wild animals in need of rescuing or who may want information on how they can help an animal. Many of Wildlife Rescue's volunteers will take injured animals to their homes and help them recuperate.

Wildlife Rescue works closely with the Nebraska Games and Parks Commission and local veterinarians. However, the volunteers receive no money from local, state or federal agencies, and the group often looks to their communities to help stock necessary supplies.

Such supplies are often the same items businesses and individuals may list with the Materials Exchange. Presently, Wildlife Rescue has listed the following

materials with the Exchange program for the construction of animal enclosures:

- Plywood—1/4" x 1' x 1' or larger,
- 1"x2"s or 2"x4"s—4 feet or longer,
- Plastic sheets—4' x 4' or larger,
- Culverts,
- Furnace ducts,
- Linoleum—scraps 4' x 4' or larger, and
- Welded wire—2' x 2' or larger.

Other items the group needs include medical supplies such as unused syringes, incubators, gram scales, and microscopes. They also need file cabinets, storage cabinets, blankets, sheets, and ravel-free fabric. They can also use certain food items and used pet items such as toys and carriers.

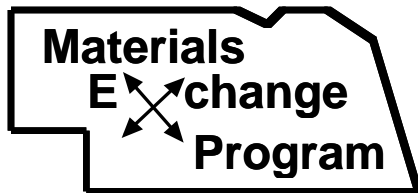

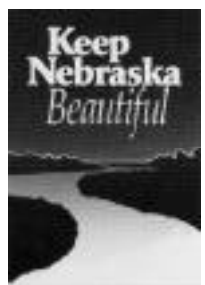
