### Computer Disposal—Problems and Solutions

Startling fact: it is estimated that every year over 750,000 computers become “obsolete”! Some consider this is a conservative estimate. Whatever the exact number, it is astounding. The potential for this quantity of waste is disheartening, but that’s not the worst of it. Computers, along with other electronics, contain a substantial amount of toxic materials.

The partial list of toxic materials includes mercury, arsenic, cadmium, selenium, chromium, and lead. Are there significant amounts of these toxics in electronics? Definitely. For example, each television or computer monitor with cathode ray tubes can contain up to eight pounds of lead. The potential release of these toxics into the environment is a significant health threat that should not be ignored. Plants, animals, and humans can all be affected. Toxic metals accumulate in the environment and can cause damage to nervous systems, blood systems, and kidneys.

The good news is there are solutions to this problem—some are already in effect. The Materials Exchange Program, we feel the best option for dealing with used computers and other electronics is reuse. Your “obsolete” computer may fill the needs of someone else perfectly. We have an extensive list of daycares, schools, non-profits, and individuals that are happy to receive older, working computers. If your computer isn’t working, we can refer you to recyclers who can squeeze more life out of the machine or its components. They treat non-working computers in one of three ways:

1) the item is refurbished and put back into working condition.

2) pieces of the item are used for parts.  
3) the item is broken down to its base components, which are recycled. (Over 97% of the materials in computers are recyclable.)

In the area of computer reuse and recycling, the Materials Exchange Program has been quite successful. During February 2001 alone, 47 computers were matched for reuse, while another 31,700 pounds of computer equipment were matched for recycling. So if you have computers or other electronics equipment that you no longer need, give us a call and we will do our best to find a new home for it, to be reused or recycled.

Another potential part of the computer disposal solution is presented in a bill, LB644, introduced in this year’s Nebraska legislative session by Senator Don Preister. The bill would create the Electronic Equipment Recycling Act. The purpose of this Act is to encourage development of electronics recycling businesses, increase public awareness of the issue, and decrease the amount of electronics equipment going to landfills. The program will be funded by a fee on the sale of each new television and computer monitor. The bill also proposes a total ban on landfill disposal of electronic equipment beginning January 2004.

The solutions don’t stop there. Computers can be designed to be more easily upgraded, extending their useful lifespan. Computers can be leased rather than purchased, which means they eventually go back to the producer. And as “consumers” we can ask ourselves if we really need that newest, fastest machine. It’s more than likely we can comfortably extend the life of the computer we have. Whatever the case, please consider the options and help us prevent computers and other electronic equipment from going to the landfill.

### A CLOSER EXAMINATION: Success Stories

#### Wood Waste to Bedding

Legacy Livestock Shavings Company fired up their business in February of this year. Their product is bagged bales of shaved wood for livestock bedding made from wood waste. The idea behind this venture grew from the need for bedding at the existing Legacy Equestrian Center near Roca, Nebraska.

The president of Legacy Companies, Scott Usher, secured an initial \$45,000 Litter Reduction and Recycling grant from the State of Nebraska to assist in this new operation start up. He has located Legacy Livestock Shavings at 5800 North 58th Street in Lincoln, a location convenient to haulers who might otherwise pay a fee to dump wood waste loads at the landfill.

Legacy Livestock Shavings is anticipating receiving much of the wood they need from construction and demolition woods, landscape trimmings, and pallets. They have worked with Veterinary Sciences departments at neighboring universities to develop guidelines for processing that is safe for animals. For example, no cherry, black walnut, or poplar wood or CCA-treated wood can be used for shavings.

A staff of three full time employees work on site with Eric Schoen to prepare the wood waste for processing through the Jackson Shaver Machine. The demand for their livestock bedding product is high and they are in need of wood waste feedstock to meet that demand across the country to stables and zoos.

Legacy became a participant in the Materials Exchange Program in December and we have already been able to find a match for them of 1,200 pallets. This match will continue at a pace of 300 pallets each month.

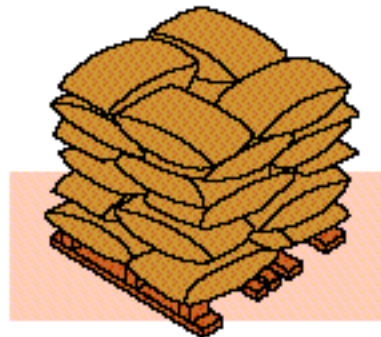

#### High Quality Paint

#### Silkscreen Ink

Another item we have listed as available is silkscreen ink. This ink comes in 32 ounce tubes in various colors. 200 of these tubes are available at a company in central Nebraska. Let us know if you are interested.

#### Low E Glass

Also available on the exchange are panes of Low E glass. This glass is energy efficient, limiting heat gain/loss through windows. 240 panes of 20"x24" glass are available.

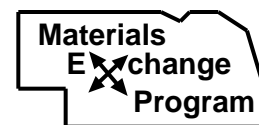
- Buy groceries in bulk

The Nebraska Department of Agriculture sponsors a program to help farmers and others properly dispose of unused, unneeded, old, or damaged pesticides. The Waste Pesticide Collection and Disposal Program serves the entire state, with nineteen collections taking place at various sites this spring. See the schedule below for dates and locations.



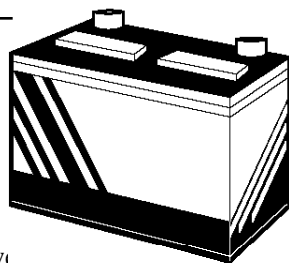
The collection will accept pesticides of all types, except those in pressurized cylinders. The product should be left in the original container and, as always, safe handling is critical. This program is for pesticides only. It **will not accept** oil, antifreeze, paints, solvents, and similar products.

There is no cost to participate with quantities of 1,000 pounds or less. For quantities over 1,000 pounds there is a fee of \$1.00 per pound and arrangements should be made by contacting Rich Reiman in advance at 402-471-6851. Hours at each collection will be from 8:00am to noon. For more information on program requirements, contact Rich or your local Extension office.

## Household Hazardous Waste Collections

Old cans of paint, varnish, and stain cluttering your basement? 20-year old pesticides in your garage? Have a mercury thermometer you don't know what to do with? While you are doing your spring cleaning you can get rid of these and similar items at your local Household Hazardous Waste Collection. Household hazardous wastes stored at home can put your family at risk and when disposed of improperly can cause groundwater pollution and pose a threat to public health and safety. Avoid these problems by taking advantage of the free collections.

Each collection has different guidelines, but commonly accepted items include pesticides (insecticides, herbicides, fungicides), paint (call first), solvents (paint stripper, varnish, stain, turpentine), items containing heavy metals (mercury thermometers), and items containing PCBs (ballasts from fluorescent lamps and capacitors from old appliances). Call the numbers listed below to learn the specific guidelines of your local collection. If your area is not covered, encourage local officials to sponsor a collection.

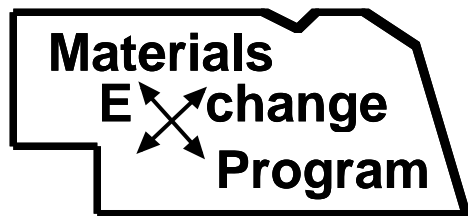

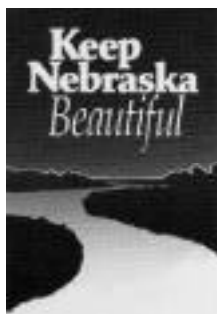
