2005 Keep America Beautiful National Awards

The annual Keep America Beautiful (KAB) National Awards ceremony was held on December 8, 2005 during the National Conference in Orlando, Florida. Sixteen of Nebraska's local affiliates garnered twenty awards presented at the Awards Luncheon.

The first place Innovation Award in the category of Litter Prevention went to Keep Columbus Beautiful. Keep Columbus Beautiful Director, Heather Buttaro, discovered a clever way to keep trash bags open with an embroidery hoop when cleanup volunteers use a litter pickup tool. Keep Nebraska Beautiful won an Innovation Award in the Statewide category. The award was given for

Keep Nebraska Beautiful's efforts in creating a methamphetamine laboratory litter awareness program, including brochures and videos. G. Raymond Empson, President of Keep America Beautiful shared, "Innovation is always a key component of developing fresh, dynamic programs that will energize communities to improve their local environments. We applaud these award-winning affiliates for developing programs that involve citizens, government and business to effect positive change."

Three awards received by Nebraska's local affiliates were given for Outstanding Sponsor Support of the Great American Cleanup™. The awards honor KAB Affiliates for staging hands-on education programs, involving sponsor volunteers/products/services during their community improvement activities, and recognizing and documenting their support. National Award for KNB Member

Mid-America Feed Yard of Ohio, NE is managed by Doug Karl and Jill Oldehoeft is Regulatory Manager. They are a member of Keep Nebraska Beautiful. The feed yard custom feeds beef cattle for its customers. Environmental compliance and stewardship are high priorities. In October of 2005, Mid-America Feed Yard was chosen as a regional winner for the Tyson Beef Environmental Stewardship Award. Tyson, Inc. then toured the feed yard and reviewed their environmental practices putting Mid-America as a semifinalist for the two national award-winner spots. In December, Mid-America Feed Yard was notified that they won the 2006 National Tyson Beef Environmental Stewardship Award. Tyson is donating \$500.00 to an environmental organization in Mid-America Feed Yards' honor. Keep Nebraska Beautiful was chosen by Mid-America Feed Yard to receive the donation. Tyson is holding a national awards banquet and presenting the award in February, 2006.

Great American Cleanup™ 2006

Although we are in the midst of winter, it is time to start thinking about spring and all that it holds in store, including winter's litter and debris. Keep America Beautiful and Keep Nebraska Beautiful have just the solution to those winter leftovers. The Great American Cleanup™ is the nation's largest annual community cleanup and beautification effort and is Keep America Beautiful's signature event. President George W. Bush and First Lady Laura Bush are the honorary chairmen.

Events are held in the spring of each year from March 1 - May 31. To ensure warmer weather for outdoor clean ups and plantings, events generally take place in Nebraska in April and May. Last year, 2.45 million volunteers donated 7.85 million hours of their time for organized events that took place across the country. These concentrated efforts helped to beautify communities all around the nation by removing 208 million pounds of litter and debris, planting 4.3 million flowers, bulbs and trees, and collecting 21 million pounds of aluminum and steel just for starters!

There are many ways in which communities can become involved in the Great American Cleanup™. Here are just a few to get you thinking toward spring in your community:

- ❖ Organize park, school or roadside cleanups and involve church groups, community improvement clubs, and students at the local schools
- ❖ Provide dumpsters in a prominent spot for residents to bring their items to or collect items curbside to encourage everyone to clean up their property
- ❖ Beautify a public space near the library, city hall or a school with flowers, shrubs and/or trees
- ❖ Organize a recycling drive and get everyone in the community involved
- ❖ Hold a clothing drive and recycle the clothing by donating it to those in need

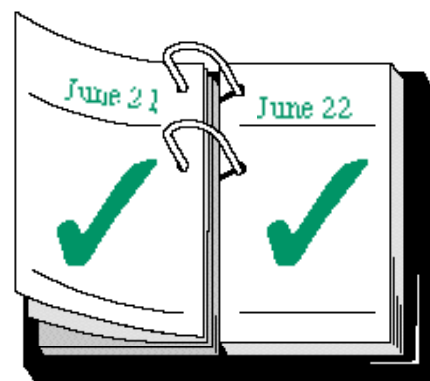
