# Reducing Contamination in Recycling

Of all the problems that afflict recycling today, contamination is the one thing we all can help to resolve. Trouble is, it's hard to know what to do when rules are different everywhere you go. From work, school or home, to parks, malls and entertainment venues, when able to recycle at all, we encounter a shifting tide of acceptable items each and every day.

Public containers and curbside bins often have labels describing what's permitted, but they can differ from one venue to the next. Even at the curbside, acceptable items can change over time, or between haulers, leaving little assurance that the same items will be accepted after a move or change in services. Online inquiries aren't any better - go to 10 different websites and you'll find numerous explanations for the exact same item. Try the mind-numbing issue of cardboard pizza boxes if you don't believe me.

Stand-alone programs for specific materials aside, the only widely acceptable items are #1 & #2 Plastic Containers, Aluminum & Steel Cans, as well as Corrugated Cardboard & Paper with restrictions. In fact given our inability to keep up with domestic demand, some argue that these are the ONLY items fit for the single source bin - especially when premiums paid for clean feedstock are taken into account.

While numerous other materials may come to mind, it's hard to find any acceptable to all haulers. From this viewpoint in fact, the only other thing that can be said for sure, is what's NOT acceptable in ANY single stream or mixed recyclable bins. Following is a list of our top 10:

Aerosol Cans: While empty containers can be considered recyclable, even the tiniest amount of paint, polish, or spot remover is considered hazardous, so better to be safe than sorry and save these for the next household waste event.

<u>Batteries</u>: Corrosive elements make batteries dangerous to workers and machines alike. Some rechargeables can even catch fire when disposed of improperly. The occasional business will take them, as will some hazardous waste drop-off events, but in the absence of either, the trashcan unfortunately beats the bin every time.

<u>Ceramics:</u> Pottery, dishes, mugs and bowls are never recyclable. Usable items can be taken to some Goodwill or Thrift Store locations, but should otherwise go to the landfill.

<u>Garden Hoses:</u> As with all cords and wires, hoses aren't necessarily bad because of the material they're made from, but for what they do to sorting machines. Rare is the "tangler" that makes it through the process without causing expensive work-stoppages to find and clear them out, so items like these belong in the trash.

Glass: Always a hazard to those working with or around it, glass should never go into a bin with other materials. While container glass is still allowed by some haulers, the contamination it imposes on other materials, simply can't be justified. The easiest material in the world to recycle, the only way it should be, is when it's separated at the source, and dumped into stand-alone bins.

<u>Lightbulbs:</u> While many types can and should be recycled through stand-alone programs, or hazardous waste events, they never belong in the recycling bin, where they're destined to break and contaminate. Glass dust coats every material it touches, and small amounts of mercury from fluorescent bulbs can pose serious health risks.

Plastic Bags: Also a tangler, plastic bags are the bane of all recycling operations. Grocery stores often have collection bins, but otherwise they should always be trashed. In fact, a paper bag would need to be used seven times to get the same energy footprint as a plastic bag used a second time and disposed of properly! That said, use in the single stream as a container for other recyclables is a definite no no.

Paper Coffee Cups: To make them more resilient to heat and liquid, paper cups are treated with a thin coating of wax or plastic. Having wedded the two, they cannot be torn asunder, making them a contaminate to both recycling streams. Unfortunately, these should always be tossed in the trash.

Styrofoam: While recycling options do exist, there has yet to be an energy study demonstrating efficiency on a scale that warrants hauling it across the country. The best solution is to ban its use whenever possible, as takeout food containers for example, and while stand alone programs exist in some communities, it should never go in the single stream.

<u>Wire Hangers:</u> The final in our list of tanglers, they cause far more problems to the sorting process than they're worth. If still in serviceable condition however, Thrift Stores will often take them for reuse in their racks.

## **Success Stories**

When it comes to equipment, furniture and supply donations to schools and nonprofit organizations, 2019 has yielded numerous successes for the Exchange. In fact, we've already surpassed yearly averages in terms of purchase savings with four months left in the year. Estimates through August total some \$58,000 saved by participants, putting us in position to see the second most productive year in that regard since at least 2004. In addition to oft seen items like bookcases, chairs, desks, file cabinets and tables, we've also found homes for a number of unique donations as well.

At the beginning of February for instance, a participant in Lincoln contacted the Exchange with the 1st snowblower offered in the history of the program. Much more than your normal residential blower, built for the average neighborhood sidewalk, this robust piece of machinery was actually a two-stage Toro 824 Snowmaster, designed for serious snow removal. We had a feeling that the response might be bigger than normal, but never would have guessed interest would top 40 email inquiries over the course of two days. While sorry to have to disappoint so many, we were glad to see the implement go to a home that could utilize its full potential an organization in Lincoln with wide sidewalks on a busy street, where lots of little feet brave many a cold after school slog.

Then in March, a longtime nonprofit participant contacted us looking to find homes for 23 brand new hospital bed mattresses sporting on demand, alternating pressure therapy. Far too long for the average bed frame (seven feet to be precise), we knew that while interest wouldn't be on the scale of February's snowblower, it would likely be intense among the organizations that could possibly use them. We heard from several over the next couple of days, but had to turn all but one lucky Omaha nursing home, that replied two minutes after the notice was posted, away.

Speaking of beds, July brought a call from a first time participant in Omaha, with some 115 bunkbed frames available for donation. With nowhere to store the units once new beds were brought in, the college only had a short window for pickup while redecorating one of their dorms. Knowing that the number of interested parties would likely be even fewer than it had been for the hospital bed mattresses, we weren't surprised to have only one group reply. With a couple of participants in pocket that either ship out of state or resell such items, (precluding them from regular donation notices) we decided to reach out to area summer camps first, in hopes of finding a group that could use the beds directly. A few expressed interest, and when all was said and done, a college in Lincoln, an Omaha "thrift" or "restore," and a camp in-between the two, had split the donation.

# Matches Needed

No matter the number of equipment, furniture and supply donations we place in a given year, there are always needs that go unmet, as organizations desperate for such items occasionally let us know. Over the last couple of years, one piece of furniture in particular stands out as something that numerous groups have a real need for - the coveted office chair. While not a bad year for chairs in general, having placed more than 100 since January, most have been of other styles like stacking, waiting room, task and guest chairs. However, with fewer than ten rolling armchairs placed so far this year, like those most often used at desks and conference tables, numerous groups are making due with what they have. We've put the word out to businesses that have donated dozens if not hundreds of such items in the past, but none are currently redecorating, or have any such items to spare. If your company has office chairs sitting in storage, or you know of one that does, please reach out and let them know about the Exchange - we'll have them spoken for faster than free tickets to a Husker game!
