



Exchange Donations in a Year of Pandemic

Equipment, furniture and supply donations got off to a rousing start in 2020 as three longtime donors placed more than 120 items in the first ten weeks of the year. In all, 19 Nebraska schools and nonprofit organizations saved an estimated \$5,000 - largely at used/yard sale prices. Then the virus hit. For four months donations understandably slowed to a trickle as businesses shuttered or sent employees to work from home.

With the exception of March, each was still brightened by a much needed, if seldom offered item. April saw 100 Paxton keyfobs and a fob-reader offered, followed by 139 stacking chairs with three rolling storage carts listed in May, and 45 metal and plastic classroom chairs donated at the beginning of June. Best of all, each came from a participating school or nonprofit looking to give back! For those that benefitted, the impact was significant, translating to nearly \$3,500 in expenses saved.

With restrictions loosened, July saw donors start to reach out again. The first actually came to the Exchange by way of a yet another participating nonprofit. Offered more office furniture than they could use, Bridges to Hope kindly passed along our contact info, and a new relationship was forged. When all was said and done, two months of generous donations saw 24 organizations receive nearly 370 items worth an estimated \$6,300! Impressed by both the straightforward process, and affable recipients, the donor made sure to note they'd be back again soon!

The next couple of weeks saw a few small donations, but then came a call we'd been waiting for. Mark Cookus, facilities manager with Union Bank & Trust, gave us a heads up back in June that big things were planned for the end

of quarantine, and that time had now arrived. After donating more than 160 items over the previous two years, they were now hoping to find homes for all the furniture in a three story building! The facility had filled numerous purposes over the years, but with yet another departmental change in the works, they decided to clear it out entirely.

With far more furniture than it made sense to list individually, Mark asked if we might try a different approach. This time, he requested we send a donation notice inviting participants to schedule viewing appointments for the second week of August, with distribution to take place the following week.

Over the next couple of days, more than 60 organizations replied to reserve appointment slots on a first come, first served basis. Thanks to both an indelible need, and the quality of furniture offered, reservation week found almost everything spoken for by Wednesday morning. When all was said and done, more than two dozen participants were able to claim more than 625 items worth an estimated \$18,750 - again, largely at estimated used/yard sale prices. Forced to buy new, the expense would easily reach four times that amount. And as always, our amazing school and nonprofit participants were exceedingly grateful! Here's How It Works!

For those unfamiliar with the Donation Program, here's how it works: 1-6 time a month donors contact the Exchange with gently used, serviceable items available - often with representational pictures. We in turn pass the information along to more than 360 contacts, representing some 250 Nebraska schools, nonprofits, and government agencies. Actually, we Bcc the group, as a number of organizations would prefer we didn't shared their contact info with anyone.

Donations range from a single desk, stapler, or box of file folders, to dozens of such items from which to chose. If interested in items being offered, participants simply reply for contact info and then get in touch with the donor to reserve what they want and work out a time to pick it up. In an effort to protect donor information, we also only send contact info to those who reply expressing interest - not the full list of participants.

We always tell donors four important things regarding the donations they make:

- 1) While general wear is fine, nobody wants damaged, incomplete or broken material, so please don't offer it.
- 2) Donations are free - even docking or warehouse fees are not acceptable. That said, transportation is generally up to the school or nonprofit.
- 3) Representational pictures help - a lot. Whether we're talking one item or 20, folks are more likely to call about items they can see first.
- 4) The program is free, all we ask in return is that donors let us know who took what - for grant reporting purposes only.

Participating schools and organizations likewise know Exchange policy states that all donated equipment, furniture and supplies received through the Exchange are intended for the use of participating schools and nonprofit organizations, or their students, clients, or members. Items are not to be sold directly, or given to a third party whose intent it is to sell said item(s), for profit - even thrift stores. (that doesn't include free stores which are acceptable). Items are also not intended for use by individual employees in the home. By replying for contact info, they acknowledge agreement with Exchange policy.

It's not uncommon for donations to be spoken for within minutes of being offered, so we always answer requests for contact info in the order they are received. Even large donations can be gone within an hour, so coordination with donors is also important. Generally, companies make materials available on a first-come, first-served basis until everything is gone. That said, the donation process is entirely up to them, so whatever the approach, it's important they do what's best for their office.

Participation in the program is free - all we ask is that donors let us know which items they were able to place, and with whom - for grant reporting purposes only. Finally, the occasional donor wants to claim the donation come tax time. It doesn't happen very often, but schools and organizations know to be prepared to demonstrate their tax exempt status, and bring a donation receipt if requested. 
