



Recycling During The Pandemic

A couple of weeks ago, EPA issued the following statement about recycling during these difficult times:

“Americans all over the country are staying home, getting more deliveries in cardboard boxes, eating at home, and generating more material than normal, much of which can be recycled.

EPA encourages households to do their part – recycle more and recycle correctly so the right materials are available for U.S. manufacturers. To do so:

- Check with your local recycling hauler to see what materials they accept right now and recycle what you can from your home.
- Break down shipping and food boxes, rinse out containers and cans, keep them dry and clean, and put them in your curbside bin to be recycled.
- Keep disinfectant wipes, gloves, masks, other PPE and medical waste out of recycling bins.

When taking trips to essential businesses like grocery stores and pharmacies, please do not litter disinfectant wipes, masks, gloves or other PPE, instead put them securely in a trash can and follow local trash and Center for Disease Control guidelines.”

Much of that depends of course, on whether or not recycling has even returned to your area. Despite the lifting of many restrictions, the risk of staff exposure led several communities to continue suspensions of both drop-off and curbside recycling services for the foreseeable future.

In communities where collections weren't interrupted, a fall in commercial recycling was often accompanied by an uptick in residential numbers, so while overall recycling

rates saw a decline, curbside programs were in some cases stretched to the limit. In an effort to get on top of the issue, Omaha even suspended curbside pickups for a day, with regular services scheduled to resume the following week.

Collections are only one of many ways reuse and recycling have been affected by the pandemic. For instance, fear of contamination caused numerous grocery stores to ban reusable shopping bags. In a similar move, many of the states and municipalities with existing or proposed bans on single use plastic bags, rescinded such orders, at least in the short term.

Increases in other un-recyclable, single-use items like styrofoam clamshells and plastic utensils occurred as well, as restaurants pivoted from in-house dining to carry out and delivery services. Disposable straws and wax paper cups also saw a rise, as convenience stores banned reusable coffee and soda containers.

Perhaps the greatest impact has been on recycling markets themselves, where the pandemic made existing problems worse. For example, China's 2018 National Sword policy caused a glut of materials in the U.S. that sent prices reeling. Recyclers of mixed paper and cardboard adjusted only to see supplies become increasingly hard to come by in the last few months, threatening a bottleneck in production. Conversely, the ever-abysmal demand for recycled plastic feedstock bottomed out entirely when oil markets entered negative territory for the first time. Whether the industry has indeed embraced recycling anew remains to be seen, but exceedingly low oil prices ensure that virgin material will remain significantly

cheaper than recycled counterparts for the foreseeable future.

While similar to paper and cardboard markets, supply reductions in aluminum and glass containers have largely been driven by just ten states. Long held as the best way to ensure bottle and can recycling, states with deposit programs are traditionally responsible for an estimated 40% of recycled aluminum, and 60% of recycled glass containers nationwide. Thanks to the pandemic and an abundance of caution, several programs including those in California, Connecticut and Michigan, have suspended some or all of their returns.

As a result, bottlers have had to rely more heavily on curbside materials, and the increased contamination rates that go with them, but the bigger problem may be with the deposit programs themselves. According to an article in the Detroit Free Press, returns have yet to resume and with few bottles and cans finding their way into curbside trash and recycling bins, an estimated \$50 million in Michigan deposits alone remain as yet unclaimed. That's a lot of dimes, and with an estimated 70 million cans and bottles generated each week, officials estimate it will take at least 6 months for the issue to work itself out.

If there's one thing that municipal, manufacturing and recycling reps agree on going forward, it's that resiliency is key not only to the continuation of local programs but for the industry as a whole. It's a new recycling world out there where those able to adapt to changing circumstances have a good chance for survival, while others, hoping for a return to the status quo, may find themselves left behind.

Keep America Beautiful Recycling Tips During COVID-19

Regulations may be shifting in communities due to the coronavirus (COVID-19) pandemic and CDC guidelines. Many communities have temporarily suspended recycling programs because of worker safety and other limitations. As always — look up what you can recycle locally.

1) If you or someone in your home has tested positive for the coronavirus, do not recycle your recyclables; place them in a bag that is securely closed and discard them in your trash container. This also applies to any used cleaning supplies, paper towels, tissues, or personal protective equipment (PPE) generated within a home or business with someone who has tested positive.

2) "Workers and employers should manage municipal (e.g., household, business) solid waste with potential or known COVID-19 contamination like any other non-contaminated municipal waste." (OSHA guidance)

3) Most cleaning supplies can be recycled. Generally, it is advised to remove the pumps and spray heads before recycling. For lotion bottles and other toiletry items with pumps, empty the contents, discard the pump, and recycle the bottle. For no-pump containers, simply empty the contents, re-screw the cap to keep it all together, and recycle. Check locally for any specific instructions.

4) Recyclables need to be dry and free of food. Be sure to reduce waste by using all the product in the container, then lightly rinse and recycle it. For plastic beverage containers — empty them, leave the cap on (in most situations), and recycle them. Empty aerosol cans (deodorant, hairspray, and sunscreen) can be recycled with other aluminum or steel cans.

5) Home items that can be recycled: toilet paper rolls, paper towel rolls, empty cleaning supply containers, kitchen plastics, clean and dry cardboard, and paper goods (cereal boxes, Amazon boxes, etc.). Commit to reducing, reusing, and recycling everyday by taking the #BeRecycled Pledge.

Keep America Beautiful is not advising the general public to use PPE to pick up litter or manage their recyclables or waste in their homes given they are in short supply & desperately needed by the medical community.

When you take out the trash, make sure it is secure — whether it goes in a bag, cart, or bin.

Please note: COVID-19 is reported to live on surfaces for an extended period of time, according to a recent study:

- As an aerosol, for up to 3 hours (e.g. sneezing, coughing, etc.)
- Clothing - several hours up to a day
- Up to 4 hours on copper
- Up to 24 hours on cardboard
- Up to 2-3 days on plastic and stainless steel
- Up to 4 days on glass surfaces like a smartphone

General health and safety:

1) Wash your hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds especially after blowing your nose, coughing, or sneezing, and before eating or preparing food. (CDC)

2) Avoid touching your eyes, nose, and mouth with unwashed hands. (CDC)

3) Cover your cough or sneeze with a tissue, then throw the tissue in the trash. (CDC)

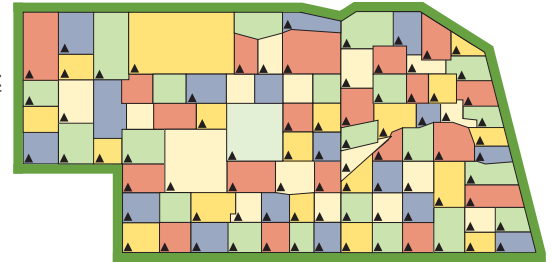
