

2020 America Recycles Summit

The spring issue of The Link discussed EPA's National framework for advancing the U.S. recycling system - a yearlong collaborative effort culminating with the 2019 America Recycles Summit. For the 2020 Summit, EPA hosted a virtual event November 17 where they facilitated discussion of its draft National Recycling Strategy, and announced the country's first ever National Recycling Goals.

EPA Administrator Andrew Wheeler announced that the agency is committed to increase the national recycling rate to 50% by 2030, recognizing that collective commitments are best achieved when we have a common goal. He then challenged businesses, communities, and individuals to embrace EPA's National Recycling Goal to help our collective efforts to improve the nation's recycling system, create more jobs, and conserve our natural resources.

The metrics identified in the National Goal are based on the broad objectives of the draft National Recycling Strategy and are divided into four categories:

- Assess recycling performance
- Reduce contamination
- Increase processing efficiency
- Strengthen recycled material markets

The National Recycling Goal aims to create standardized defi-

nitions for the recycling industry to keep pace with today's diverse and changing waste system. The draft strategy will identify actions needed to address these challenges that build on the collaborative efforts by stakeholders from across the recycling system that began under the National Framework for Advancing the U.S. Recycling System.



They also announced three measures to support that goal and evaluate performance:

- **Measure 1:** Reduce contamination in recycling. Reducing the percentage of wrong materials in the recycling stream helps ensure clean recyclable materials, such as paper, glass, or plastic, can be processed and made into new products. To do this, we need to increase public education and outreach. **How EPA will measure this:** By calculating the percentage of contaminants (wrong materials) in recycled materials.

- **Measure 2:** Make our recycling processing system more efficient. Making our processing system more efficient will help more of the material that is intended to be recycled get recycled. We can achieve this through improvements to our processing system by investing in new equipment upgrades and making curbside recycling accessible for more Americans. **How EPA will measure this:** By tracking the percentage of materials successfully recycled through a recycling facility compared to the materials that the facility receives.
- **Measure 3:** Strengthen the economic markets for recycled materials. Strengthening economic markets will help manufacturers make more products using recycled materials and encourage consumer demand for more products made with recycled materials. To do this, we need to educate the public about the importance of buying recycled and increase demand through policies and incentives that focus on materials with less mature markets. **How EPA will measure this:** By tracking the average price of a ton of recycled materials (also known as the commodity value) on the market.

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Peter Wright, EPA assistant administrator for the Office of Land and Emergency Management, spoke about the four issues that will be addressed by a National Recycling Strategy:

- Confusion regarding what types of items are recyclable and how to minimize contamination.
- Old recycling infrastructure and the investment needed to increase processing capacity
- Action needed to strengthen domestic markets for recycled materials and to better integrate recycled materials and end-of-life management into product and packaging design.
- The patchwork of state and local approaches as to what's recyclable and how recycling is defined makes it very difficult to measure and track national progress.

Wright identified problems in the U.S. recycling system that led to the launch of the Americas Recycle Summit and other efforts to find solutions to a broken value chain. At its most basic understanding, the National Recycling Strategy addresses municipal solid waste (MSW).

"This refers to the various items that consumers throw away after their use," he said. "The National Recycling Strategy identifies short- and long-term actions to improve the recycling system that can be taken by anybody, and not just by EPA or the federal government."

First is the issue of addressing contamination at the residential level. Because it affects the quality of recycling materials, contamination makes the bale less desirable in the marketplace. The EPA plans to improve and increase public education and outreach to alleviate the issue.

"As it's been said, people want to recycle, but they continue to be confused about what to put in the bin,

and it depends on where they live," Wright said. "We need to increase access to information about recycling, for example, by sharing best practices, and analyzing different recycling policies, so that we shape the path forward for consumers and make it easier for them to follow."

The second objective addresses the aging infrastructure of MRFs, which have not evolved along with the different materials used in consumer products.

"Unfortunately, new products are not always designed to be well matched to the ability of existing infrastructure to recycle them," he said. "We need to look at the infrastructure as it exists today and figure out the gaps and needs. We need investments to make improvements to the existing infrastructure funding is available, but it's not always easy to find. We recognize that innovative technology can improve sorting efficiency at MRFs, and more research and development on technologies is needed."

Product design also is a priority.

"We also need to take a step back and see how we design products in the first place to see whether they're designed to be easily recycled at MRFs," Wright said.

When it comes to the National Recycling Strategy's third objective, strengthening the market for recycling, increasing demand is key. "We want to make sure that it covers all the right things," he said. "Specifically, we're interested to know what actions people think are the most important."

Lastly, standardized definitions, measures, targets and performance indicators are needed to allow for a common recycling language to be adopted. After that, EPA's next step will be to develop a roadmap for implementing the strategy.


