

Reuse: A Materials Exchange Priority

For more than 40 years, recycling has been synonymous with efforts to divert material from our nations landfills. Since the earliest days of the environmental movement, its symbol has been among the most recognizable icons in the world. Often considered the cornerstone of waste reduction, recycling is definitely the easiest diversion category to quantify. When recycling statistics are shown, in any context, one gets a sense of where we stand, and how far we have to go.

However, our ability to get good statistical data from the process doesn't make it the most productive waste management strategy for every material. In fact recycling has actually done little over the years, to reduce the amount of disposable material entering the market in the first place. In the hierarchy of the 3 R's of waste management (Reduce, Reuse, Recycle), it is the lowest priority, since by definition, materials have to be broken down and reconditioned before being used as, or in another product. This process, and the energy required, denotes an inherent cost not associated with reuse.

Overall reuse rates, on the other hand, are impossible to calculate, as landfill diversion can only be guessed at unless an item changes hands. Even when it does, there is seldom a process in place to track it. The mountains of material that surely pass through garage sales and thrift stores nationwide for example, is indicative of just how difficult the prospect is. That said, tracking

done by programs like the Materials Exchange, can provide a glimpse of the impact such reuse markets generate.

In the last 20 years, Materials Exchange Program matches have diverted more than 348 million pounds of waste from Nebraska landfills, only about 45% of which was recycled. Categories with significant recycling totals include Ag Products (compost), Durables & Electronics, Metals, Paper & Cardboard, Plastic, and Rubber. For what it's worth, more than 24 million pounds of Oil (tallied at 8 pounds per gallon) is also counted as recycling, since it's used in asphalt production, though the oil itself isn't necessarily reconditioned before entering the process.

Conversely, certain reuse markets are often thought of as recyclables, since they have an infrastructure in place similar to those in the recycling industry. For example, Containers & Pallets – including drums, gaylords, and the like, are actually more of a reuse category, with more than 51 million pounds or 85% returned to market. Only when they deteriorate to the point of being worthless, do "recyclers" in fact recycle them.

Always our first priority, industrial peer-to-peer reuse matches are only tracked when third party brokers, or facilitators like the Exchange are there to make the connections. For example, the most successful reuse category, Wood, is also our best category overall, with nearly 105 million pounds diverted. Although a small portion has been recycled for use in fuel pellets, the vast

majority has been reused as animal bedding. Going strictly by weight, Textiles & Leather is the least successful Exchange reuse category at just over 171,000 pounds. When one considers the number of art projects, quilts, clothing, and couch covers that represents however, 85 tons is pretty impressive.

Items in every category we track were exchanged with reuse in mind, while recycling went matchless in 5. More than 90% of all Chemicals, Construction Materials, Food, Sand/Gravel, Surplus Equipment, and Wood diverted have gone for reuse. That's more than 200 million pounds of waste diverted, for which the energy costs of additional processing wasn't required. Virtually all non-profit, school, and agency matches, can also be defined as reuse. While their matches are by no means limited to Surplus Equipment, groups from around Nebraska have received more than 800,000 pounds of desks, chairs, file cabinets, and the like over the years, for an estimated purchase savings of more than \$1.1 million. One of the most exciting things about reuse today is that materials once landfilled without a second thought are now seen as commodities to be sold or traded with others who can use them. It's a paradigm shift that requires creative thinking, planning, and a broad range of contacts in which the Materials Exchange is excited to play a role. It's also a part of what those suggesting a 4th R mean when they say Reduce, Reuse, Recycle, Rethink!

- Helps sustain the environment for future generations.
- Reduces the amount of waste that will need to be recycled or sent to landfills and incinerators.
- Allows products to be used to their fullest extent.
- Saves money.

Ideas on How to Reduce and Reuse

- Think Green Before You Shop. Reduce associated greenhouse gas emissions by thinking green when you shop.
- Reduce your food waste by shopping smart, buying what you need, composting food scraps, and donating unused food to food banks or shelters. More ways to reduce your impact.
- Reuse or repurpose items such as old clothing, cloth grocery bags, and

containers to prevent waste.

- Buy used items to reduce waste as well as the emissions created by producing new materials or disposing of them in landfills. Donate unused clothing, electronics and building materials to make sure others can reuse them too!
- Buy products made with recycled content. Check labels to see if a product or its packaging is made from recycled materials.
- Know before you throw. Know what items your local recycling program collects and encourage your household to recycle right and recycle more.
- Learn about what else you can do at home, at school, at work and in your community!
- Maintain and repair products, like clothing, tires and appliances, so that they won't have to be thrown out and replaced as frequently.
- Borrow, rent or share items that are used infrequently, like party decorations, tools or furniture.

One person's trash is another person's treasure. Instead of discarding unwanted appliances, tools or clothes, try selling or donating them. Not only will you be reducing waste, you'll be helping others. Local churches, community centers, thrift stores, schools and nonprofit organizations may accept a variety of donated items, including used books, working electronics and unneeded furniture.

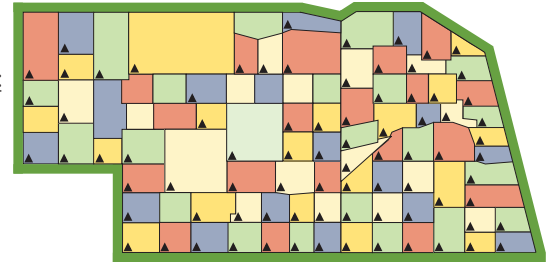
