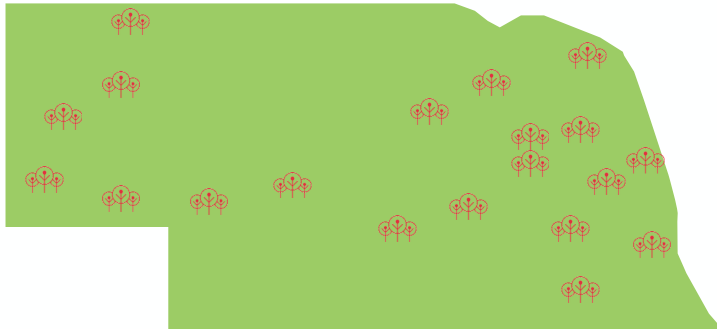

School Chemical Cleanout Campaign:

Clean out 15 school chemistry labs and janitorial closets across Nebraska. With an average cost of \$7,500, your membership is vital to helping us keep Nebraska students safe!

Materials Exchange Program:

Increase Materials Exchange Program landfill diversion rates by 25%. With your support, KNB looks to divert some 7,000,000 lbs. of material from Nebraska landfills through reuse and recycling exchanges.

Used Oil Collection Program:

Provide needed maintenance to Used Oil Collection Program tanks, ensuring host sites can provide the service for years to come. We also aim to expand the service by 1 or 2 counties. At more than \$20,000 per tank, your membership will help make this a reality.

OUR PROGRAMS



Nebraska School Chemical Cleanout Campaign

Since its inception, the School Chemical Cleanout Campaign has disposed of more than 41,800 lbs of hazardous chemicals from over 258 educational institutions. Revived in 2022 after a five-year hiatus, the program is working to keep schools safe for years to come.



Materials Exchange Program

The Exchange redirects significant amounts of waste stream materials from Nebraska landfills through industrial exchanges, with an active network of 700 schools and nonprofit organizations. As a result, donors generously contribute equipment, furniture, and supplies to these institutions.



Food Waste Reduction Program

The Food Waste Reduction Program combats the U.S.A.'s #1 category of Municipal Solid Waste. Our newsletter, ReFresh Nebraska, identifies issues and solutions from farm to fork. We've also created an Afterschool Food Club curriculum and Eco Fair demos that help students identify food waste solutions in their own lives.



Used Oil Collection Program

The Used Oil Collection Program is sustained through the collective sale of the material for use in asphalt production. The program has placed collection tanks in 67 counties and has seen more than 3.03 million gallons collected statewide.



Household Hazardous Waste Program

In addition to one-day collection events that accept household hazardous waste from local residents, this program includes permanent waste collection facilities for citizens across Nebraska.
